

# Five Things To Do To Help More Lost Dogs Get Home



1. Never hesitate to call, text or email an owner directly if you think you have seen a post or ad for a dog that may match their missing dog.
2. Use your cell phone camera to take pictures of lost and found dog posters, and any loose dogs that you see that may be someone's missing dog.
3. Print and post flyers of lost and found dogs missing in your community at your place of employment, vet clinic, and any community bulletin boards where people frequently look.
4. Encourage your local shelter or animal control facility to post pictures of found dogs they have impounded on their Facebook page and website.
5. Share our posts via social media including Facebook, Twitter, Pinterest, Instagram, Google +, and any other social media platforms that you use.
