

There's a new place for pooches to play in Trumbull County!

On August 7, 2013 a dedication ceremony welcomed the new exercise area at the county dog kennel located on Anderson Avenue.

The project, which was approved by Trumbull County Commissioners, provides a fenced in area next to the kennel to give active dogs a place to exercise and improve behavior to help with the adoption process.

The new exercise area is named after Holly Jordan. Holly was a nurse for 21 years. She had to leave work on disability due to her heart condition. Instead of sitting at home she has been coming to the Dog Pound to care for the dogs.

For 6 years Holly has been a full time volunteer at the Trumbull County Dog Warden's office. She is with the dogs Monday through Saturday. The dogs love her, even the most fearful or angry dog's love Holly and find comfort in her gentle soul. It is a rare dog that she cannot handle. Our high adoption rate is directly attributed to Holly's devotion.

You can find Holly at adoption events and at the pound most days and even on holidays. Holly is a lifelong resident of McDonald, Ohio. In December 2010 Holly was sworn in as a Dog Warden.
